- ✓ Names and addresses of involved companies

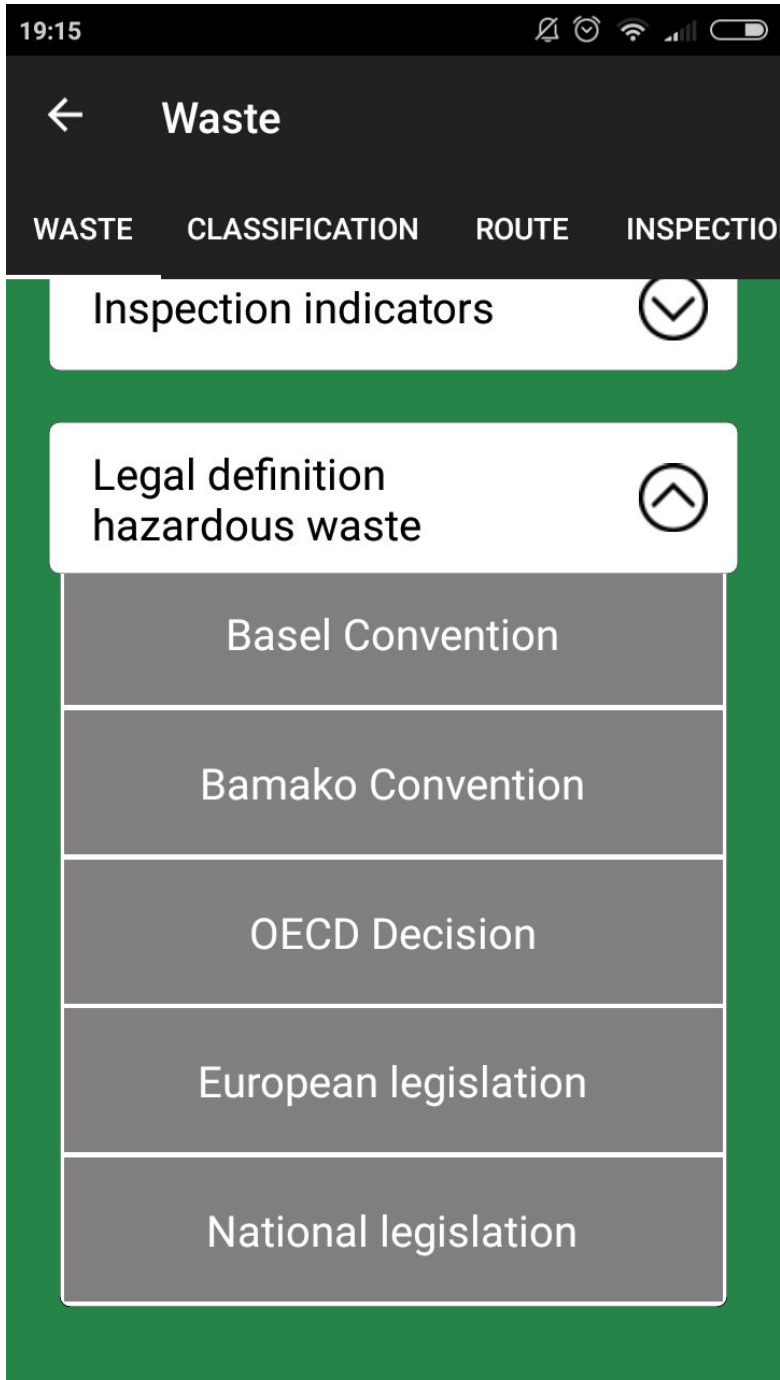
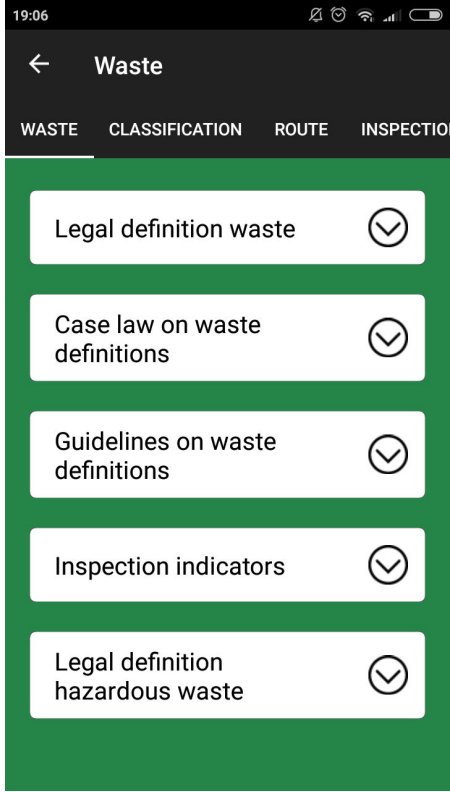

Under the Basel Convention, Parties have specific obligations to transmit certain information to each other, through the Secretariat. This includes notifications of national definitions of “hazardous wastes” that are additional to the wastes listed in the Annexes of the Convention, thereby expanding the scope of the Convention.

Revisión anexo II, propiedades de los residuos peligrosos

If a waste is identified as hazardous, by a specific or general reference to dangerous substances, the waste is hazardous only if the concentrations of those substances are such that the waste presents one or more of the properties (H-Criteria) listed in Annex III to Council Directive 2008/98/EC. As regards H3 to H8, H10 and H11 certain threshold levels for classification as hazardous are set out in Article 2 of Decision 2000/532/EC establishing a list of hazardous waste.

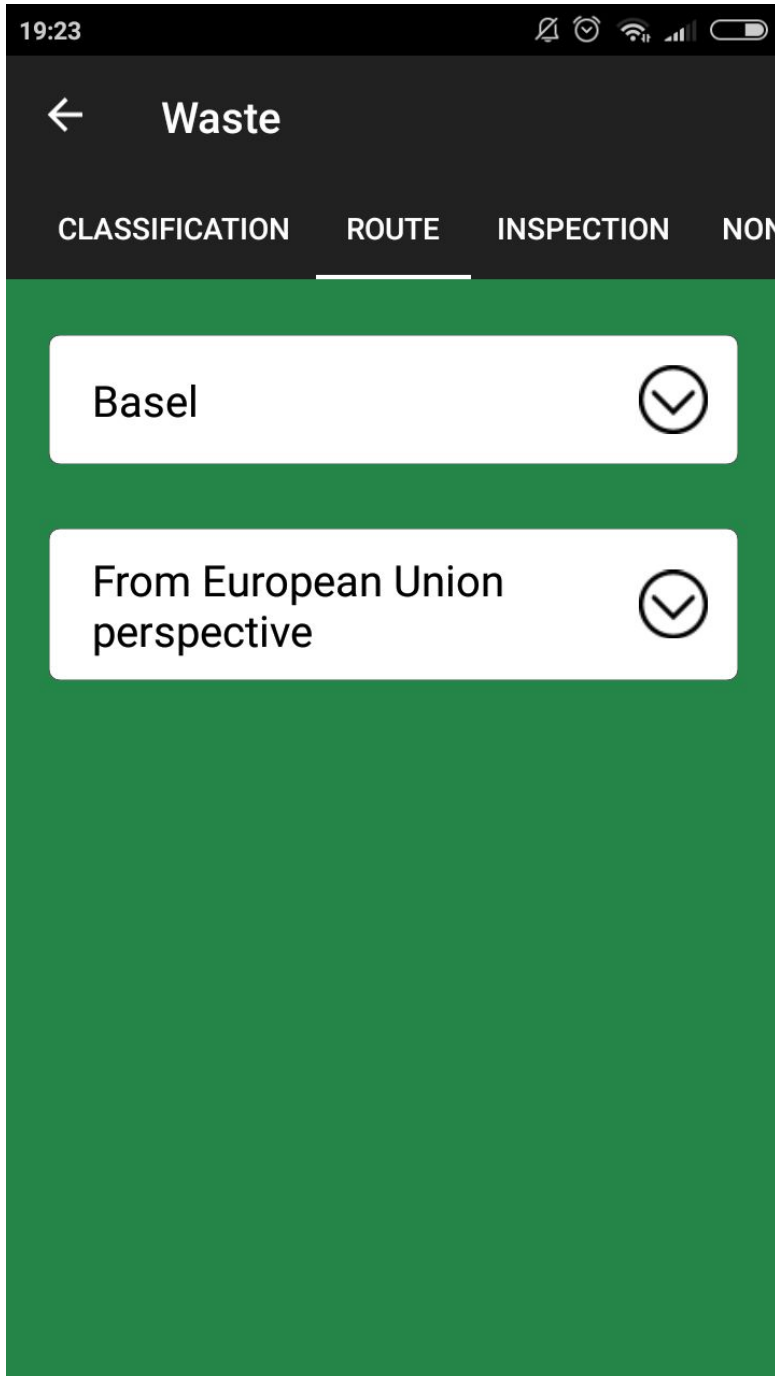
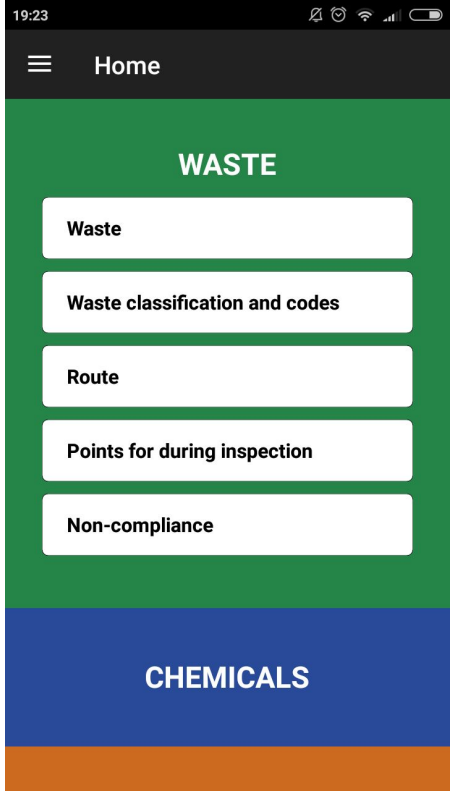

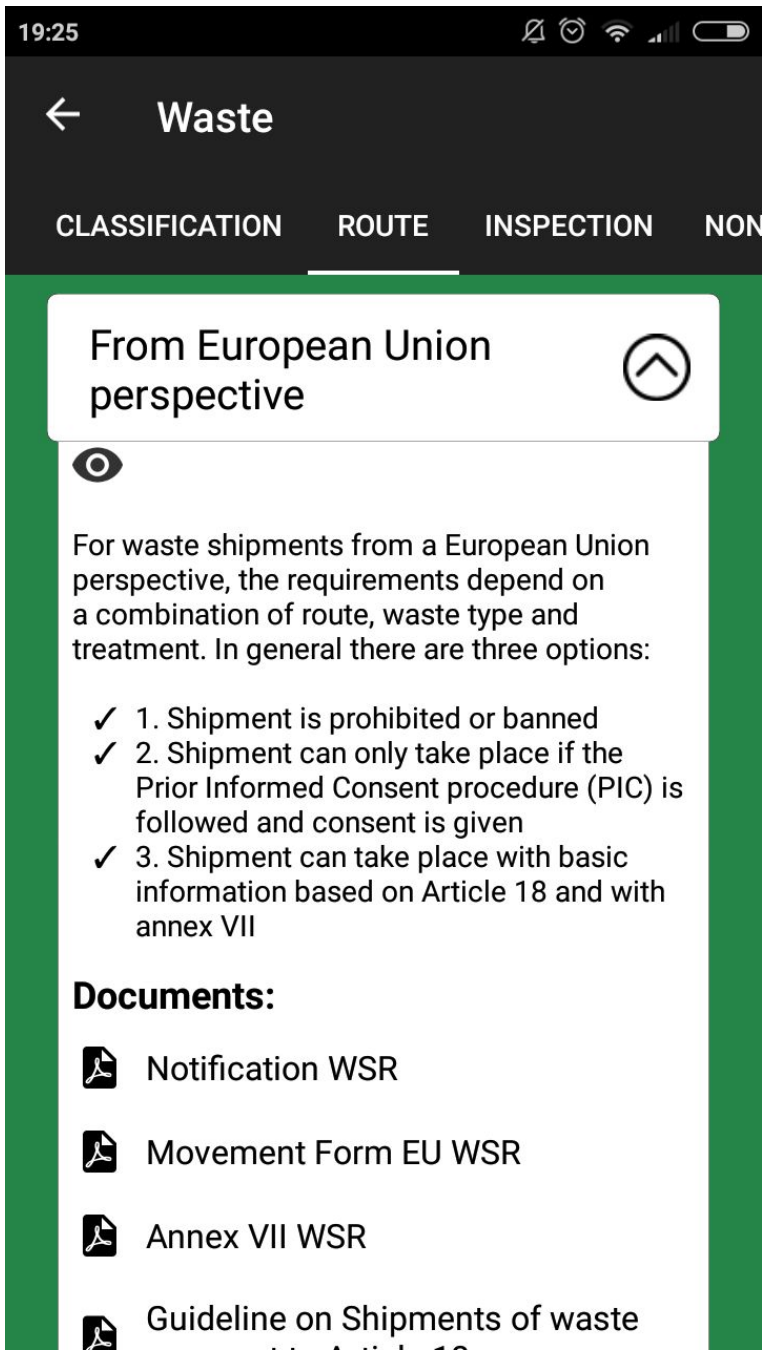
ANSWER:
Not permitted, unless bilateral, multilateral or regional agreements/arrangements are in place. These arrangements must include standards for environmentally sound management of waste which is not less than in the Basel Convention. Parties must notify the Secretariat of any agreements.

From European Union perspective



For waste shipments from a European Union perspective, the requirements depend on a combination of route, waste type and treatment. In general there are three options:





- ✓ 1. Shipment is prohibited or banned
- ✓ 2. Shipment can only take place if the Prior Informed Consent procedure (PIC) is followed and consent is given
- ✓ 3. Shipment can take place with basic information based on Article 18 and with annex VII

ION ROUTE INSPECTION NON-COMPLIANCE

Responsibility of the importer or disposer (Article 9.3)

The State of import shall ensure that the wastes in question are disposed of in an environmentally sound manner by the importer or disposer or, if necessary, by itself within 30 days from the time the illegal traffic has come to the attention of the State of import or such other period of time as the States concerned may agree. To this end, the Parties concerned shall co-operate, as necessary, in the disposal of the wastes in an environmentally sound manner

Responsibility cannot be assigned (Article 9.4)

The Parties concerned or other Parties, as appropriate, shall ensure, through co-operation that the wastes in question are disposed of as soon as possible in an environmentally sound manner either in the State of export or the State of import or elsewhere as appropriate.
